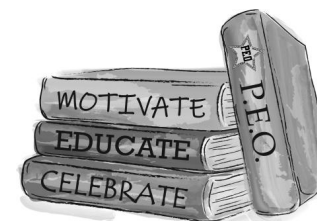

DIRECTIONS TO VENUES

Attic Angel Place, 8301 Old Sauk Rd., Middleton:
